ARTHUR BAY / BEACH A1

95min, 3,400m walk from the shop. Part sealed road then all grass and gravel trail. Along the way you will see rainforest, very old cycad palms and views of Mackay, Basil Bay and Arthur Bay beaches - perfect spots for swimming and a picnic.

CONNIE BAY / BEACH C2

70min, 2,900m walk from the shop. Part sealed road then gravel trail. You will pass Horse Shoe Bay and the lookout. You will see Keswick Island beehives, views to St Bees Island, a freshwater Tea-tree swamp, then arriving at Connie Bay/Beach - another great spot for swimming and a picnic. Look out for turtles hatching in the months from Nov to Feb.

HORSE SHOE BAY H3

5min, 200m from the main Connie Bay trail. Along the way you will see rainforest with a cascading creek in the wet season. This downhill decent will become the new road to the Marina when developed. When arriving there is a partly sandy bay for walking along.

HORSE SHOE BAY LOOKOUT H4

5min, 200m from the main Connie Bay trail. This is a slow climb through low bush land, leading out onto rare grassland with views over to St Bees down to Connie Bay/Beach and to the north the Whitsunday Islands and back along Keswick overlooking the airstrip.

EAGLE VIEW PLACE LOOKOUT E5

30min, 1.25km walk from the shop on a sealed road. Along the way you will walk through Keswick Island residential area, arriving at the lookout with stunning views to across to Mackay.

CORAL GARDENS LOOKOUT C6

2min, 100m walk from the road to Coral Garden Lookout. Along the way you will walk through Keswick Island residential area, arriving at the lookout with stunning views to St Bees.

BASIL BAY TO RAINFOREST B7

5min, 170m walk from Basil Bay Beach. Winding your way up through the creek passing an array of trees and arriving at a very old and rare cycad palm, with views over Basil Bay.
